Midreshet B'erot Bat Ayin offers women seeking to join the Jewish people through an Orthodox conversion with the Rabbanut of Israel a warm, structured, and spiritually grounded environment in which to build a committed Torah life from the inside out. Conversion students engage in serious textual study of Halachah, Jewish belief, Tanach, Hebrew language, and lived Jewish practice, while participating fully in community life, Shabbatot, and the daily rhythm of Torah life in Israel. Students are paired with adoptive families and welcomed into our many host families within the warm community of Bat Ayin for Shabbatot and Jewish holidays, allowing them to experience authentic Torah family life in a warm and supportive environment.

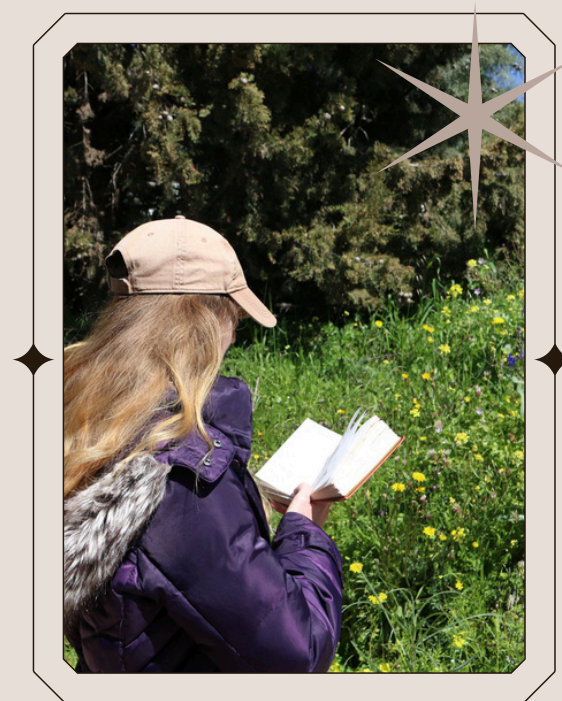
